

## What is CCR? Why should I register? How do I register?

**What it is:** The Central Contractor Registration (CCR) is the primary registrant database for the U.S. Federal Government. CCR collects, validates, stores and disseminates data in support of agency acquisition missions.

**Why you should register:**

According to [FAR 4.11](#), prospective vendors must be registered in CCR prior to the award of a contract, basic agreement, basic ordering agreement, or blanket purchase agreement. Both current and potential federal government registrants are required to register in CCR in order to be awarded contracts by the federal government.

**How you register:**

Go to [www.ccr.gov](http://www.ccr.gov) and click on “Start New Registration.” (It should be noted that Registrants must update or renew their registration at least once per year to maintain an active status)
